




## Piper PA-31 "Navajo"

The PA-31 Navajo is a family of cabin-class, twin-engine aircraft designed targeted at small-scale cargo and feeder liner operations and the corporate market. It continues to prove a popular choice, but due to greatly decreased demand across the general aviation sector in the 1980s, production of the PA-31 ceased.
